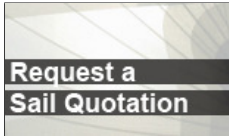

Hoisted Measurements

With tape rule fully hoisted on the jib halyard, please measure:

A- To the feeder (if any)

B- To the bearing surface of the tack fitting

C- To the intersection of the headstay and the deck

D- To the cabin house at the mast

E- To the hull-to-deck joint

F- Pass the tape measure around shrouds as if it was the leech of the sail, then measure to the forward end of the track. Pull tight.

G- Pass the tape measure around shrouds as if it was the leech of the sail, then measure to the aft end of track

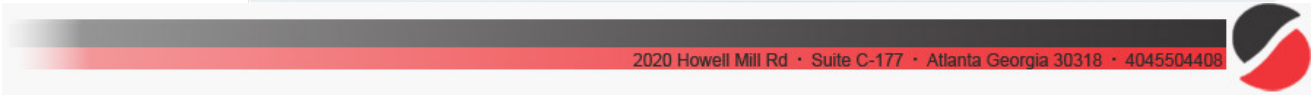
